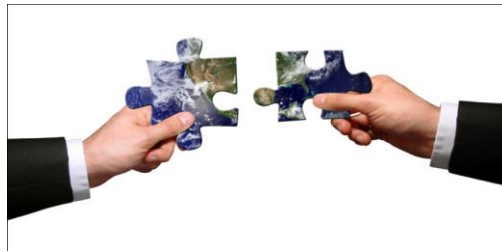

This includes solicitation in the lobby, parking lot or other portion of the facility at which the event is being held. The no-suitcasing policy includes a prohibition against non-sponsoring companies representing their services or soliciting conference participants for non-CAI social activities.
